***Providing FREE environmental job training to support  
local hire in rural Alaska communities***

**STRUCTURE OF TRAINING PROGRAM:** Training takes place over 7 weeks with a combination of in-person Anchorage based classes--with travel covered, and at-home classes over the computer. Participants must commit to all seven weeks to attend.

**TRAINING DATES:** Students must be available, **March 23 –May 4, 2023.** *Students will fly in at the beginning (12 days) and again at the end (8 days) with computer classes in between. A short break will be provided, mid training.*

**EXPERIENCE GAINED:** RACEJT trains you for a career in helping your community and region. Graduates receive a Program Diploma and 15+ course certifications, qualifying them for many job positions, including Waste Collector, Landfill Operator, Contaminated Site Worker, Tank Inspector, Brownfield Technician, Recycling Center Manager, Environmental/IGAP Assistant and many others.

**COLLEGE CREDIT:** Ten college credits and a University of Alaska Occupational Endorsement as a Rural Waste Management & Spill Response Technician.

**PLACEMENT:** Job search and job retention skills taught and practiced; placement assistance provided.

**ELIGIBILITY:** RACEJT is open to under-employed rural Alaska residents. Our goal is to place graduates in a local job position that helps to protect community environmental health. Applicants with strong potential to secure local or regional employment will receive priority program acceptance.
