STRUCTURE OF TRAINING PROGRAM: RACEJT is a residential style training; two weeks in Anchorage, two weeks home on break, two weeks in Anchorage. Participants must commit to all 5 weeks to attend.

TRAINING DATES: Two required sessions March 18 – 29, and April 12 – 23, 2024 in Anchorage with some virtual classwork at home during the break.

Graduates receive a Program Diploma and course certifications, qualifying them for many job positions, including Waste collector, Landfill operator, Contaminated site worker, Tank inspector, Brownfield technician, Recycling center manager, and many others.

COLLEGE CREDIT: Earn ten UAF college credits and conferral of a UAF Occupational Endorsement as a Rural Waste Management & Spill Response Technician.

RETENTION/PLACEMENT: RACEJT has a 84% retention rate and 98% job placement rate. Job search and retention skills taught, and placement assistance provided.

ELIGIBILITY: RACEJT is open to under employed rural Alaska residents. Our goal is to place graduates in a local job position that helps to protect community environmental health. Applicants with strong potential to secure local or regional employment will receive priority program acceptance.
