

Rural Alaska Community Environmental Job Training Program (RACEJT)

YEAR 2025 APPLICATION INFORMATION

Deadline to Submit Is Friday, November 29,2024

The RACEJT program provides environmental job training to increase local rural community employment in contaminated site cleanup, waste management, and other environmental and "green industry" jobs. It is our goal to have a trained, environmental technician in every rural Alaska community.

Graduates earn up to 10 credits from the University of Alaska, Fairbanks and complete the University's Occupational Endorsement program for Rural Waste Management and Spill Response Technicians. Accepted participants must commit to attending the full training which includes two, in-person training sessions in Anchorage as well as virtual/zoom classes in between, a short break will be provided; Tentative Dates; March 31-April 11 and April 24-May 9, 2025. Virtual Dates: April 14 – 18. Planned skills to be taught include, but not limited to:

PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

- Applications must be received no later than midnight on Friday, November 29th, 2024, to be considered for RACEJT 2025 training.
- Must be a resident of a rural Alaska Native community (defined as 30% or greater Alaska Native population).
- Must be 18 years of age or older, or an emancipated minor.
- Must be unemployed or under employed (working no more than 20 hours/week average in prior year).
- For consideration, you must be willing and able to attend the FULL training, including <u>both</u> inperson sessions, in Anchorage <u>AND</u> the five days of virtual/computer classes on the following dates

Session 1 and 2 held in Anchorage:

March 31st - April 11 and April 24th - May 9th

<u>Virtual classes</u> at home community during the Apr 12th – Apr 23rd break (RACEJT provides airfare):

April 14th - 18th

- Must have a high school diploma or GED or obtain a GED by November 29th, 2024
- Much of the environmental work for which you will be trained requires heavy lifting and working outdoors. You must be physically fit, able to work in confined spaces, and able to wear a respirator mask. If you are you unable to perform heavy lifting or other essential job functions but have an employer who is willing to hire you then you may submit an employer letter, and you will still qualify for the program. Letters must be received by December 8th, 2024.
- Must provide 2 completed personal reference forms. Reference forms are provided along with this application packet and are due November 29th, 2024.
- RACEJT funders require a copy of your social security card. Therefore, if accepted, you must
 provide a copy. If you do not have a copy you will need to begin the process of attaining one
 as soon as possible as the process can take a couple of months. For your convenience, we
 can provide the form upon request, if you need to apply for a copy of your social security card.
- Must consent to a criminal background check.
- A potential job lined up is <u>not</u> a requirement of the program. We will assist you with job
 placement if needed. However, you will be given priority acceptance if you meet the below
 guidelines.

GAINING PROGRAM PRIORITY ACCEPTANCE

To obtain priority for program acceptance, you need to identify a specific job position for which an employer will hire you once you are trained.

- To document this job, you must arrange for your potential employer to attend your phone
 interview (described below). If this is not possible, you must provide a letter from your
 prospective employer (i.e. Tribal or City Council member, project contractors, corporations,
 etc.) that recommends you to the program and confirms that they or a project contractor
 will hire you following the completion of the training program.
- Do you work 20 hours or less per week total, currently? You will receive priority if your employer can commit to increasing your wage and/or increasing the number of hours you work upon completion of the training. Your employer must attend your phone interview (described below) or furnish a letter/email by December 8th, 2024 that confirms their plan for an hour and/or wage increase.

These phone sessions are very helpful and serve to answer any questions or concerns that you have. We want you to be comfortable that this program is the right one for you and the right time for you.

If you include an email address in your application, you will receive a confirmation email stating that we received your application. Note: If you choose to mail your application, please note that if it's **postmarked after November 29th**, we cannot accept it.

Step 3: In addition to your online application, you will need to have two people fill out online references for you. Make sure the two people filling out your personal reference forms also submit the **online forms by the application deadline of November 29th, 2024.** The online instructions and forms can be found on the same webpage as the RACEJT application and can be completed and submitted there. If sending hard copy forms, <u>all must be submitted directly to us</u> through email, fax, or mail (post marked no later than November 29, 2024).

Step 4: Call-in for a short, 20 minutes, <u>required</u> telephone interview that we will schedule with you in October, November and December 2024. Each interview takes 20 – 30 minutes, employers should be on the interview call with you if applicable. The interviews are recorded for our selection team to review.

Step 5: You'll be notified if you are tentatively accepted to RACEJT on or before **January 3, 2024.** We will work with you to complete the final program requirements.

If Accepted:

You will receive an acceptance packet that must be completed and returned no later than **January 17**th, **2025**

Step 6: Join us for 3 Required Teleconference calls for an overview of what to expect.

Please note: If you fail to attend any of these meetings and do not schedule an alternate time, you could be disqualified from attending the training. If you have a conflict with both times and/or day, please contact April right away to reschedule a different time.

- The <u>first call</u> is: <u>Friday</u>, <u>January 10th from 10 11 am *OR* 1 2 pm</u>. This call will review acceptance packet materials and answer any questions you have about RACEJT.
- The <u>second required call</u>, regarding <u>logistics, travel and virtual training</u>, is <u>February</u> 11th, 10 11 am

The <u>third required call</u> is about <u>checking in</u> before flying into Anchorage and <u>making the</u> <u>most</u> of the RACEJT Program March 27th, 10 – 10:30 am.

You MUST be on all three mandatory calls to confirm your seat in the training program. Missing any of the required calls without contacting program manager and rescheduling, can disqualify you from moving forward in the selection process

It is the intention of RACEJT to secure the travel funding necessary for all students to attend the program. If accepted into RACEJT you may be asked to complete a scholarship application to your regional Corporation, Regional Coastal Program, or other Community Development Programs offering training assistance. This is to help cover your costs of the program and allows us to provide full scholarships for those unable to obtain outside assistance.

PHONE INTERVIEW

You will be contacted within 5 business days of application receipt and if you qualify, we will schedule a phone interview. The interview will last 20 – 30 minutes and will consist of basic, non-technical questions. The purpose of this interview is to make sure that the program is a good fit for you and you for the program, this year.

If you have a potential employer, please arrange for them to attend (by phone or in- person). If your future employer cannot attend the interview, they must provide us a letter stating their commitment to hire you. **This letter is due no later than December 8**th, **2024.** Without employer attendance or a commitment letter, you will receive a lower-ranked score during the selection process. If you have questions concerning this policy, please contact us.

To screen everyone and complete the selection process by January 2nd, 2025 we need to contact you right away to schedule your phone interview. **It is critical to provide a working contact number** or message phone and/or working email address that we can use to reach you. We must be able to read your contact information easily.

MORE INFORMATION

We highly recommend attending one of the three informational teleconference calls if you have questions. RACEJT is an excellent training opportunity that is demanding of your time and requires a personal commitment to, and focus on, learning new skills. Attendance at the teleconferences will help you know what to expect during the application process as well as what to expect during the training program.
